### Summer Heat Dangers in Dogs

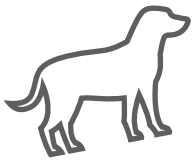

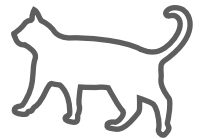
